

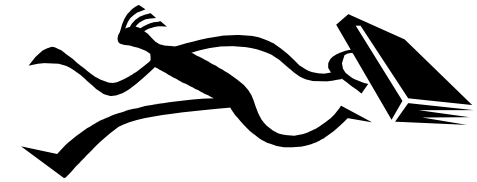
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**Mauldin United Methodist Church has a mission to develop and carry out a communications plan so that members and others in our community will understand and become interested in participating in our church.**

- ◇ To maintain a relationship with local television and radio stations in order to promote our events

- ◇ To produce weekly flyers to be placed in Sunday School classrooms to inform members of up-coming events.
- ◇ To advertise through signs, posters and banners, inside and outside of our church building.
- ◇ To maintain a website for church wide events and services, including a youth page as an important part of this website. The website will also provide links to connect users to the larger body of the United Methodist Church including affiliated institutions and resources.
- ◇ To scout out new ways to keep our message in the community and shared within the church.



- ◇ To coordinate and participate in promoting our slogan and logo throughout the church and the community through useable items, such as shirts, hats, license plates, etc.
  - ◇ To stay in close contact with other committee chairpersons in order to know what events and information need to be publicized.
  - ◇ To fully participate in the Administrative Board and the Council on Ministries.
  - ◇ To be accountable to the Charge Conference through the Administrative Board.

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## How can working on the Communications Committee enrich

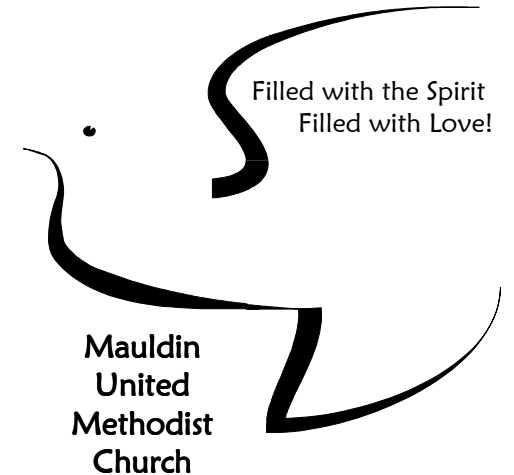
