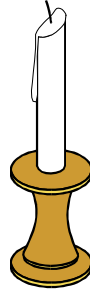
**Wedding Coordinators:** Our church has a number of individuals who are trained as wedding coordinators. All weddings held in our facility are done so with the assistance of one of these persons. The coordinator makes sure that the ceremony flows smoothly and that the interests of the church are protected.

**Flowers:** Each week we have a beautiful arrangement of fresh flowers in our sanctuary. Individuals volunteer to place these in the sanctuary often as a way of honoring or remembering loved ones. During special seasons (Easter & Christmas), Easter lilies and poinsettias are used to beautify our church.

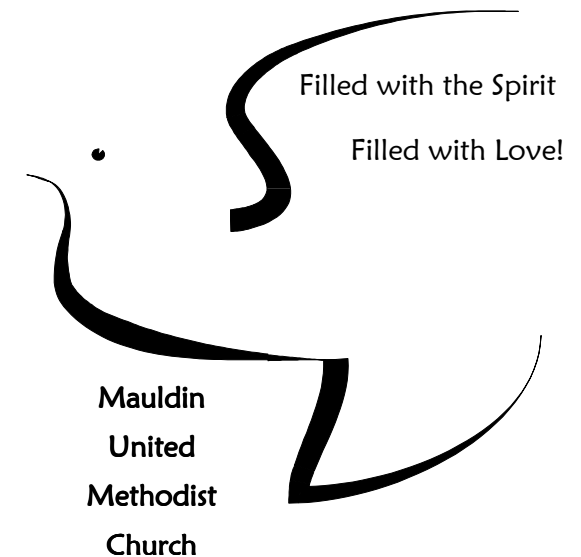
**Paraments:** Individuals from the worship committee make sure that the paraments on the pulpit and alter are changed in accordance with the church calendar.

**PURPOSE OF**

**WORSHIP COMMITTEE**

**The purpose of the committee is to oversee and coordinate all aspects of worship services.**

**This is to ensure that an environment is created that enables the Holy Spirit to work effectively within our congregation.**

The committee is composed of ten to fifteen members that are approved by the charge conference. The chairperson serves on the Council of Ministries. Meetings are held as necessary to fulfill the committee's mission, usually meeting once every two months.

**Music:** Choirs are organized for all age levels from children through adults. Choirs provide music leadership at all worship services. The Praise Band provides music leadership for the Live Services. Handbells for adults provide additional musical support. Soloists, musicians, and choirs bring special blessings throughout the year.

**Ushers:** Usher teams serve at each service. They hand out bulletins, welcome those who attend, take up offerings, and insure that the need of all worshipers are met in an orderly and efficient manner.

**Communion Stewards:** An effective Communion service cannot be held without lots of prior preparation. Our communion stewards ensure that the elements (bread & wine) are in place and that acolytes are prepared to replenish items as necessary.
